Minister The Light of Christ. **People** Thanks be to God.





But chiefly are we bound to praise you for the glorious resurrection of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord; for he is the true Paschal Lamb, who was sacrificed for us, and has taken away the sin of the world. By his death he has destroyed death, and by his rising to life again he has won for us everlasting life.

We give thanks to you, O God, for the goodness and love which you have made known to us in creation; in the calling of Israel to be your people; in your Word spoken through the prophets; and above all in the Word made flesh, Jesus, your Son. For in these last days you sent him to be incarnate from the Virgin

Mary, to be the Savior and Redeemer of the world. In him, you have delivered us from evil, and made us worthy to stand before you. In him, you have brought us out of error into truth, out of sin into righteousness, out of death into life.

WORDS OF INSTITUTION

Jesus ate with his friends many times. They would eat and talk, often asking questions and wondering about God. On their last night together, after their conversation at the table, Jesus took bread, he blessed and broke it, and shared it with his friends, saying, "Take, eat. This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Then Jesus took the cup, gave thanks and poured it out for his disciples, saying, "Take and drink of this cup. This is the cup of the new covenant. Do this in remembrance of me."

We pray you, gracious God, to send the power of the Holy Spirit upon this bread and this cup that these gifts may be for us the Sacrament of your healing presence among us in a broken world. Feed us with your power; fill us with your peace, teach us how to love; lead us, reconciled and redeemed, into the world to work for the liberation and reconciliation of all Creation. Strengthen those whom we love, who suffer on this

day, including those whom we name now out loud or silently in our hearts.

Minister God in your mercy, **People Hear our prayer.**

Minister By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of

the Holy Spirit all honor and glory is yours,

Almighty God, now and forever.

People AMEN.

Minister Let us pray the prayer taught to us by our brother

Jesus.

People Our Creator who art in heaven, hallowed be

thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the

power, and the glory, forever. Amen.
