The Good Friday Offering

The Good Friday Offering was instituted in 1922 as an intentional response of The Episcopal Church to support Anglican ministries in the Province of Jerusalem and the Middle East that were impacted by the devastation of World War I, the Spanish flu pandemic, and social and political unrest affecting Armenian Christians, among others throughout that region.

While the issues that haunt the Holy Land today are different, they are no less pressing. St. George's will join the global Episcopal effort and will be collecting an offering on Good Friday for the Province of Jerusalem. Envelopes will also be available for offerings the following two weeks.
